(Note: Close contact is defined as within 6 feet for more than 10 consecutive minutes) <p>Note: All answers shall be included in the original referral email to the Weatherization Agency.</p>	WHEAP WX
3.3.3	Tribal Homeownership	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If the dwelling is on tribal land, a fully completed Tribal Attestation of Homeownership is the preferred proof of ownership. The documentation shall show that a household member is the current owner. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. The Tribal Attestation of Homeownership form is available on the HE+ website under “Furnace Program Documents.” 2. The attestation form must be signed and dated by a tribal official. 	WHEAP WX
