

## EHH/ESG-CV Office Hours May 2022

### ESG-CV 2020-2022

- A second round of reallocations of ESG-CV funding was approved late April; contract amendments will be executed in early May
- New HUD Notice (CPD-22-06)
  - Extends federal expenditure deadlines (at this time, state deadlines remain the same)
  - Describes recapture and reallocation process
    - There is a possibility that WI will receive additional funds; will find out in July/August 2022
  - New waiver: Housing Stability Case Management Limits (correcting prior oversight)
    - Waives the requirement that limits the total period of time a participant may receive housing stability case management to 24 months during any 3-year period
    - Fully retroactive

### EHH 2022-2023

- The application was released March 29<sup>th</sup> and is due Monday May 9<sup>th</sup>
- In the weeks following the due date, certain attachments will be needed; each grantee will be notified on what they need to submit
- Award letters for HPP and HAP funds will be sent out next week; ESG awards will be noted in the contract, which should come out early June (we are still waiting on the HUD award notification)
- DEHCR will hold a mandatory virtual meeting with all EHH 2022-23 grantees (lead agencies and subrecipients) in early June to discuss requirements and expectations; the meeting will be recorded for those who can't attend live

### Fair Market Rent Waiver

- DEHCR plans to submit a request to HUD to waive the FMR requirement for ESG
- It is a process that will take several months
- At this time, we are outlining the steps needed and will soon start to collect data from the local coalitions
- If approved, the waiver would last 12 months from the date of approval

### CAPER 2021

- The performance period is April 1, 2021 – March 31, 2022. *Note: this includes two EHH grant cycles.*
- All projects that incurred any ESG expenses in that time period will need to have a CAPER report uploaded into SAGE; this does NOT include ESG-CV funding and does NOT include HPP-only projects (unless used as ESG match)
- An email asking for project verifications was sent to Lead Agencies; it is due 5/10
- Once all projects are confirmed, they will be uploaded into SAGE and the system will send out links to all project contacts to upload their CAPER; the due date for uploads will be 5/20
